

# Minimum Eligibility Criteria for LSE

## A) Regular Learning Support Educator

Applicants must be:

Eligibility requirements for REGULAR LSE:	
i.	Proficient in the Maltese and / or English Languages;
ii.	In possession of a recognised full qualification (Degree) at MQF level 6 or higher (subject to a minimum of <b>180 ECTS/ECVET credits</b> , or equivalent with regards to programmes commencing as from October 2003) in <b>INCLUSIVE EDUCATION</b> or a comparable professional qualification;
iii.	In the absence of applications from eligible candidates according to paragraph ii, and/or in the absence of successful candidates, eligibility shall be extended to applicants in possession of a recognised full qualification (Diploma) at MQF Level 5 (subject to a minimum of <b>60 ECTS/ECVET credits</b> , or equivalent, with regards to programmes commencing as from October 2003) in <b>INCLUSIVE EDUCATION</b> or a comparable professional qualification;
iv.	In the absence of applications from eligible candidates as per paragraph iii and/or in the absence of successful candidates, eligibility shall be extended to applicants in possession of a recognised full qualification (Certificate) at MQF level 5 (subject to a minimum <b>30 ECTS/ECVET credits</b> , or equivalent ) in <b>INCLUSIVE EDUCATION</b> or a comparable qualification;
v.	Qualifications at a level higher than that specified in the paragraphs above will be accepted for eligibility purposes, provided they meet any specified subject requirements. A Masters qualification at MQF Level 7, or equivalent, must comprise a minimum of 60 ECTS/ECVET credits with regards to programmes commencing as from October 2008;
Moreover, candidates who have not yet formally obtained any of the above-mentioned qualifications will still be considered, <b>provided that they submit evidence that they have been approved for the award of the qualifications in question, or successfully completed the necessary ECTS/ECVET credits, or equivalent, taken as part of a higher recognised MQF level programme of study, as required in the afore-mentioned eligibility criteria</b> by the closing time and date of the call for applications.	

## B) Supply Learning Support Educator

Applicants must be:

<b>Eligibility Requirements for SUPPLY LSE:</b>	
i.	Proficient in the Maltese and/or English Languages;
ii.	In possession of a First Degree at MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS/ECVETS or equivalent, or a recognized appropriate comparable qualification; <b>or</b>
iii.	In possession of a recognized qualification at MQF level 5 with a minimum of 30 ECTS or equivalent in Inclusive education and:  <b>1.</b> A pass (Grade 1-5, Grade C) in 4 subjects at MQF level 3 which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject; <b>or</b>  <b>2.</b> A full MQF level 3 VET Qualification, or a Secondary School Certificate and Profiling qualification at MQF level 3 in 4 subjects which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject as separate study units within the course pursued. <b>or</b>
iv.	In possession of a full recognized qualification at MQF level 4 in Health and Social Care, Children’s Play Learning and Development, Children’s Care Learning and Development and  <b>1.</b> A pass (Grade 1-5, Grade C) in 4 subjects at MQF level 3 which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject; or <b>2.</b> A full MQF level 3 VET Qualification, or a Secondary School Certificate and Profiling qualification at MQF level 3 in 4 subjects which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject as separate study units within the course pursued.  <b>or</b>
v.	In possession of any subject at Advanced Matriculation Level (minimum grade E) at MQF Level 4 and:  <b>1.</b> A pass (at least at Grade 1-5, Grade C) in four (4) subjects at MQF Level 3, which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject; or <b>2.</b> A full MQF level 3 VET Qualification, or a Secondary School Certificate and Profiling qualification at MQF level 3 in 4 subjects which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject as separate study units within the course pursued.
